U.S. Chemical Safety and Hazard Investigation Board (CSB) Investigation Exercise – Facilitator Guide

Purpose

To review facts from an accident investigation conducted by the CSB and discuss various actions that might have prevented the incident.

Time Requirement: 1 hour minimum

Number of Facilitators: 1 or more, consistent with ratio shown in Minimum Criteria

Materials

- Whiteboard and markers
- Technology computer(s)/devices, projector, screen, cables, internet access/flashstick

Facilitator Preparation

- Review incidents found at https://www.csb.gov/. This includes videos, completed investigations, and content found in CSB Investigation Digest.
- Select the most relevant incident(s), based on your knowledge of the participants.
- Prepare to present the content by ensuring internet access during the course, downloading to a flashstick or printing onto paper.
- Review the potential questions below and prepare to lead a discussion.

Procedure

Have participants review the incident individually or in groups. Facilitate a discussion. Potential discussion questions are found below.

Potential Discussion Questions

- 1. What were the root causes of the incident?
- 2. Were there any warning signs prior to the incident?
- 3. Were good work practices being put to use?
- 4. How could this incident have been avoided?
- 5. Were there gaps in the ability to respond?
- 6. What are the response considerations?

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
